JUNE 9TH, 2010 ATV CLUB MEETING MINUTES

- Meeting called to order by President Steve Lobitz at 7:12 PM at Club House.
- Secretary's report was mailed out with newsletter. Motion to approve by Warren Martiny and 2nd by Kendall Johnson.
- Treasurer's report handed out. Motion to approve by Judy Martiny and 2nd by Gary Koel.
- A Welcome to Don Mrotek from the Sawyer County Alliance and Steve Bethke, a club member, but is now retired and able to attend our meetings.
- RAFFLE TICKETS SALES SLOW, only 61 tickets sold as of this date. Remember this is our only fundraiser, please buy your tickets. Drawing is September 8th, 2010. Only 200 tickets sold at \$50.00 each.
- CORRESPONDENCE: Parades-1st one is the Mikana Parade on Saturday July 3rd at 2 PM, meet at Drew's Storage Shed, line up is from 12:45 to 1:45 PM. Hope to see you there, 2nd one is the Bluegill Festival Parade on July 18th at 1:00 PM, line up starts at 11:45 AM.
- On Saturday July 17th, the Birchwood ATV Club will sponsor the Kid's Games at Doolittle Park starting at 12:00 noon.
- Marty suggested we attend both of these parades. Come and join us for a fun filled time and also show support for our club.
- Marty made a motion to join the Blue Ribbon Coalition for another year at \$100.00 and Bob Lewis 2nd the motion.
- TRAILS: 31S culvert washed out again. Steve Lobitz jumped on the band wagon and had it fixed before any of us knew about it. Great Job Steve!
- The question was brought up about putting a bridge in this area where the culvert keeps washing out, Forester Greg Peterson is getting the paper work started, but it will take about 3 years before the project is started. We also are going to ask for rehab work on this trail (31S) at the same time.
- There was a lot of discussion on trail maintenance on trails 31N, 3 & 26. 31N should be done this week. As soon as they get done hauling gravel and etc., our club will do the finishing touches with the back blade. 31N to Chit Chat needs rehab also. Don Mrotek is working on getting Greg Peterson to ride some of our trail system and show him the problem areas first hand and the safety concerns we have.
- We will purchase T-posts to use for putting orange fencing and also some cable ties to attach the fencing to the posts. We must turn in bills to Don Mrotek by July 1st to get the funding this year.
- Work Day is set up for June 17th to do signing on trail 3 from Sis to Sis road. Meet at club house at 9 AM.

- Stone Lake Township is looking at opening more town roads for ATV's and also Long Lake Township is checking into opening more town roads for ATV's. Watch the newsletter for information and also check our website.
- Craig Minnick said the grader the club purchased to go on the front of the posi-trac is working great.
- CAUTION: Loggers are still working on or near a lot of our trail system. BE VERY CAREFUL WHEN RIDING THESE TRAILS.

Truck should be available for pick up sometime in early Aug. 2010. \$1,000 down payment requested to hold the truck within 7 days of your offer being accepted. Minimum offer accepted, \$12,001. LUV/UTV: LUV/UTV use on ATV Trails: The Washburn County Board of Supervisors passed a resolution on Tuesday April 20, to authorize participation in a new Utility Vehicle (UTV) 2 year pilot project.

The resolution permits UTV's (formerly Lightweight Utility Vehicles) to operate on County ATV trails. The State Statute language also stipulates that all Townships are automatically authorized to participate under the County resolution. Townships may elect to opt out of the program by adopting a resolution to that effect.

Washburn County will permit vehicles with side by side seating, steering wheel, stock cargo box, less than 1300 pounds and narrower than 65 inches. Go carts, golf carts, miniature pickups, pugs, argos and others are specifically excluded and are not legal to operate on ATV trails in Washburn County.

The Washburn County definition is intended to allow vehicles such as Razor, Rangers, Mules, Prowlers, and Big Reds, while excluding heavier, wider utility vehicles powered with diesel engines.

UTV's (LUV's) will be legal to operate on our trail systems when our trail systems open on Saturday morning of Memorial Day Weekend.

The Non-Resident ATV Trail Pass MAY NOT be used on UTV's on public trails. Both Resident and Non-Residents who wish to operate their UTV on trails participating in the pilot program must register their UTV with the DNR by completing an ATV application for public use by calling the DNR 1-888-936-7463.
